# AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCES INSTITUTE

**FIRST:** The name of the corporation is Health and Environmental Sciences Institute (hereinafter referred to as "HESI").

**SECOND:** The period of its duration is perpetual.

**THIRD**: The purposes for which HESI is organized and will be operated exclusively are to conduct charitable, scientific, and educational activities within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and the regulations and rulings promulgated thereunder (the "Code").

The primary goals of HESI are (a) to identify and evaluate scientific issues related to human health, toxicology, risk assessment, and the environment that are of mutual concern to the public, the scientific community, government agencies, and industry; (b) to contribute to the resolution of such issues through the sponsorship of scientific research and educational activities and collaboration with government agencies, academic institutions, and other scientific organizations; (c) to assist other charitable, scientific, and educational organizations in the conduct of similar activities; and (d) to do everything necessary, proper, advisable, or convenient for the accomplishment of HESI's purposes and goals and to do all other things incidental to them or connected to them that are not forbidden by these Articles of Incorporation, the Act, the Code, or by any other law. The purposes of HESI are to be carried out on a global basis, but individual activities may have a regional or national focus.

HESI shall not be operated for profit and shall not issue shares of stock. The income, assets, properties, and services of HESI shall be used exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

**FOURTH:** The corporation shall have members within the meaning of the District of Columbia Nonprofit Corporations Act, as the same may be amended from time to time. The members may be referred to in the bylaws by one or more appellations other than the word "members."

**FIFTH:** The classes, rights, obligations, and qualifications of the members shall be set forth in the bylaws.

**SIXTH:** The manner of election or appointment of the Board of Directors (which shall be referred to as the "Board of Trustees") shall be provided in the bylaws.

**SEVENTH:** The powers and activities of HESI shall be managed by the Board of Trustees in accordance with the bylaws and shall be subject to the following restrictions and limitations:

- (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, only such powers shall be exercised as are in furtherance of the purposes of HESI, and as may be exercised by an organization exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code and by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 of the Code.
- (2) No part of the assets or net earnings of HESIHESI shall inure to the personal benefit of any trustee, officer, or employee of HESI, or any other person, except that reasonable compensation may be paid for personal services which are reasonable and necessary to carry out the purposes of HESI.

- (3) None of the assets or property of HESI shall, upon liquidation, dissolution, or winding up of HESI, whether voluntary, involuntary, or by operation of law, be distributed to the trustees, officers, or employees of HESI, or to any other person. Furthermore, upon liquidation, dissolution, or winding up of HESI, such assets or property shall be distributed to one or more organizations which would then qualify under the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Code. Provided, however, that any asset or property held by HESI upon condition requiring its return, transfer, or conveyance, which condition occurs by reason of the liquidation, dissolution, or winding up of HESI shall be returned, transferred, or conveyed in accordance with such requirement. Any such distribution or any such return, transfer, or conveyance, shall be made in accordance with the Act and with Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.
- (4) HESI shall not carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation, except to the extent permitted under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code. Furthermore, HESI shall not participate or intervene (including the publishing or distributing of statements) in any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

**EIGHTH:** The address, including street and number of the initial registered agent of the corporation is 1025 Vermont Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20005, and the name of the initial registered agent at such address is CT Corporation System.

**NINTH:** The number of trustees constituting the Board of Trustees is 30, and the names and addresses, including street and number and zip code of the persons who are to serve as trustees until their successors are elected and shall qualify are:
